Childcare Resources is a nonprofit that has spent more than 30 years helping children from working families access the high-quality early education they deserve. Focused on the years that matter most, birth to age 5, the organization supports children, families, and educators through a connected, three-part model.

That model includes wellness and early intervention services that promote healthy development through early screenings and on-site therapy support for young children and their families. Childcare Resources also leads an outreach program for early educators, offering training, coaching, and professional development that strengthens the quality of care across Indian River County. At the center of this work is their NAEYC-accredited early learning school, where children receive nurturing,

developmentally appropriate education that prepares them for kindergarten and beyond.

Last year, Childcare Resources impacted more than 4,000 children through its school, educator outreach, and family support services.

Childcare Resources invites the community to support this work at Starfest on February 10, 2026, at Quail Valley River Club. This special evening will feature Major General Mike Hall and raise critical funds to ensure local children and families continue to receive the support they need to succeed.
